California's standards for public education require innovative approaches to learning. Grants from the Foundation enable El Segundo public schools to go beyond basic state funding to help prepare our students for lifelong success.

In the Bridge the Gap campaign, Superintendent's Roundtable donations accounted for one-third of the entire campaign grant. Recent ESEF grants to the El Segundo Unified School District (ESUSD) have provided:

- \$250,000 in 2005, for new state-required Language Arts textbooks for K-8th graders; a modernized sound system and refurbished grand piano for the high school auditorium; equipment for the high school's new science building; and other technology requirements within the ESUSD through the Bridge the Gap campaign.
- \$140,000 in funding for the specialized elementary art and music programs in the 2003-2004 school year through the Pledge to the Arts campaign.
- \$85,000 to install PowerSchool® in 2002-2003, a Web-based attendance and classroom performance system providing secure online access to teachers, students, and parents.
- \$300,000 in 2001, for a high-speed wide area network connecting the ESUSD's schools to each other and to the Internet.

Our academic programs have been strengthened over the years because of the support made possible through the El Segundo Educational Foundation. Your contribution will be put to work to further our goal of preparing El Segundo students for lifelong success!
